

MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING

of the WILLIAMSON COUNTY AMATEUR RADIO CLUB

February 22, 1979

ATTENDANCE:

The regular monthly meeting of the Williamson County Amateur Radio Club was held in the Jonah Community Center at Jonah, Texas. It was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by its President, Bob Petrosky, N5TT.

OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was given with a total of \$150.21 balance in the club treasury.

The Vice-President's report was given, stressing the importance of publicity for the upcoming Clipperton DX-pedition presentation.

Due to the absence of the Activities Chairman, the President gave the activities report, reminding everyone of the upcoming Field Day event and asked for equipment donations by members.

Ideas and input from the members were asked for by the President concerning the club logo.

Club name tags were also briefly discussed with no action taken at this time.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Proposed Budget for the Calendar year 1979 was presented for discussion and approval by the membership. There were no amendments to the budget, and it was approved as presented.

It was suggested by the President that members should think of ways of raising funds for support or maintenance up-keep of the 146.04/.64 repeater station used locally.

New committees were announced, consisting of: TVI/RFI Committee, members being W5VDR, K5KL and AJ5V; Refreshment Committee (to be rotatable), WD5AAL; Publicity Committee, N5AKJ; and Novice Instruction, AJ5V.

Proposed adjournment of the meeting was to immediately follow the program, given by Bill Sorrel, WD5AAN. The program was a very informative discussion and slide presentation of some of the facets of Archeological exploration and methods, with the slides showing before and after results of site investigations.
