

MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING  
of the WILLIAMSON COUNTY AMATEUR RADIO CLUB  
July 26, 1979

ATTENDANCE:

The regular meeting of the Williamson County Amateur Radio Club was held in the Jonah Community Center at Jonah, Texas. It was called to order at 7:36 p.m. by its President, Bob Petrosky, N5TT.

There was a total of 6 members present.

OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the previous meeting were then read and approved as presented.

The membership discussed and decided that a list would be available to the club members for them to place their name and call sign if they so desire a name tag. The cost is \$2.00 per each, payable in advance. It was also decided that the order would not be placed until or unless there are at least ten names on the list.

NEW BUSINESS:

It was brought up for the club's consideration to participate as coordinating communicators for the annual Georgetown Tennis Finals, held once a year in July. Club members would provide radio communication between the various tennis courts in Georgetown via the 2 meter frequency. The playoffs normally last for 3 days, and communication is required daily from approximately 8:00 a.m. until approximately 9:00 p.m. This year there were approximately 600 entrants, and next year there are an expected 1100 entrants from the central Texas area. Communications this year was via the Citizens Band frequencies, with extremely unsatisfactory results.

At approximately 7:50 p.m. the meeting was adjourned.
